## President's Report

- Provincial Lockdown ending next week with return to colour framework
  - o Anticipated return to Red Zone with similar parameters from when shutdown began
    - Would result in skills and drills
    - To be announced Feb. 16<sup>th</sup>
- Potential to extend season to the end of April or even into May
- Arena eager to assist league with return to plan
  - Kim to inquire about accommodations for goalie dressing, such as extending access time to arena.
- OMHA meeting each center asked about plan to return to play with majority intending to continue the season once the lockdown is lifted.

## Return to Play Board Discussion

\*Brad to follow up via email with all coaches and inquire on intent to continue in coaching position for the remainder of the season.

- Kim to confirm with municipality re: anticipated return to Red Zone with similar parameters as December:
  - o 10 skaters + 2 coaches + 1 Trainer
  - 1 ice time per team per week
  - No games or scrimmages
  - No spectators, however, 1 guardian for players under 18 years of age permitted.

\*Kim to initiate email communication between board members regarding status of coaches per team and municipal regulations.

- o Target return to ice date: Feb. 19<sup>th</sup>
- Resume same scheduled ice times per team as was in place at the time of the shutdown in December
- March Break moved to April this year due to COVID
  - o Regain March Break ice and continue play foregoing the annual shutdown
- Discussed potential extension of season to the end of April or into May
  - Should zone colour advance potential for games/ scrimmages between age groups and possibly with Orono – pending parameters outlined by DPH
  - Consider potential overlap with sports typically run in the spring.
  - o Determined not enough information at this time to determine a season end date.

\*Kim to communicate with parents regarding next steps once confirmation of provincial and municipal guidelines are received.
